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WHAT'S Si-Lab?

Si-Lab project aims at improving the employability of students developing some of the most valued skills in the labour market, namely innovation, creative thinking and digital skills, through the concept of "i-Lab" to school environment.

An i-Lab (innovation laboratory) is an inspirational innovative facility designed to transport users from their everyday environments into an extraordinary space, encouraging creative and innovative thinking as well as collaborative work towards problem-solving.



Si-Lab FIRST TRANSNATIONAL MEETING

Our project started on 17th December 2020 at "Prof. Dr. Assen Zlatarov" School in Sofia, where the partners met to kick off implementation of its activities. The team focused on realization of the two core outputs of the project:

- Output 1 - Creation of i-lab: guidelines about how to create an i-lab space according to student's necessities!
- Output 2 - Online software for i-lab creation: the development of software in order to guarantee access to i-lab spaces also online for students from 12 years old up.



WHAT HAVE WE DONE SO FAR?

At this initial stage of the project activities, from 24th to 26th February 2020 partners have already completed the first training activity in Katerini (Greece) to which teachers and educators from each partner countries participated.

The training focused on explaining what an i-lab is, how can be used in terms of activities and tools (both digital and not digital) and how spaces can be created to fulfill students' necessities.

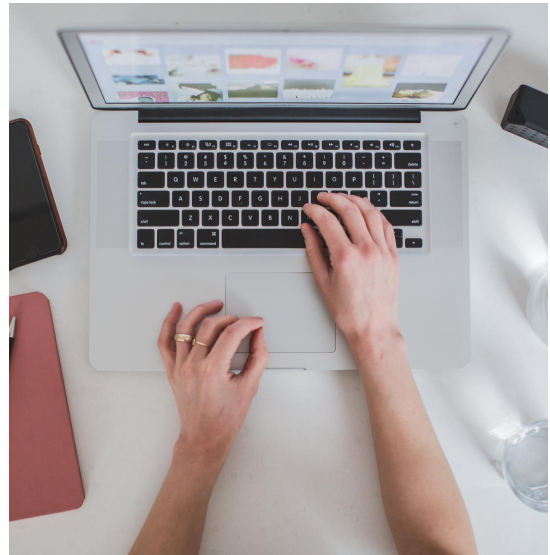


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WHAT'S NEXT FOR Si-Lab?
